

# Colby 8th grade girls capture conference title

The Colby 8th grade girls' basketball team, coached by Liz Gottsch, took first place at the Northwest Kansas League Tournament in Colby on Feb. 21, and first place in the final NWKL tournament in Oakley on Feb. 28. Managers of the team are Brett Wilson, Chris Haeffner and Janessa Rasmussen.

Here is a recap:  
**Colby**—The 8th grade girls played Oakley in their first game of the tournament, winning it Colby 35 to Oakley's 15. Zanea Baird was the high scorer with 9 points, Jessica Stephens 7, Shea McKee 6, Morgan Stephens 5, Andrea Barker 4, Jacquie Fry and Shannon Oard 2 each, and Nickole Schroeder 1. Katie Friesen also saw floor time.

In the championship game of this tournament the girls played Hoxie, winning the game and the championship with a score of 33 to Hoxie's 22. The high scorer in this game was Zanea Baird with 12. Morgan Stephens followed with 8, Jessica Stephens 5 and Andrea Barker and Shea McKee each putting up 4. Jacquie Fry also saw floor time.

The conclusion of the league was played out in Oakley with the top two teams of the Colby tournament playing for the top two teams from the

Goodland Tournament for final NWKL Championship.

**Oakley** — The Colby 8th graders played Quinter in their first game of the tournament winning it with a score of 27 points over Quinter's 21. The high scorer of this game was Zanea Baird with 9 points. Morgan Stephens scored 6, Jessica Stephens and Andrea Barker each 5 points and Jacquie Fry 1 point. Other players seeing floor time were Shea McKee, Shannon Oard, Nickole Schroeder, Katie Friesen, Emily Dougherty, Christy Gerstner and Elaine Lamm.

In the final game to determine the NWKL champions, Colby beat Hoxie 40 to 27. Hoxie had played Goodland, winning 32 to 30 to advance to the championship bracket. Zanea Baird was high scorer with 16 points followed by Jessica Stephens with 15. Morgan Stephens added 7 and Andrea Barker had 2. Other players seeing floor time were Shea McKee and Jacquie Fry. The girls played a strong defensive game to win this final game for the league championship. The Colby 8th grade girls finished the season with a 12-1 win loss record, losing only to Hays Kennedy.




