Cut a thin slice from top of cheese. Scoop cheese out, leaving a 1/2 to 1 inch shell. Finely shred scooped-out cheese. Set cheese bowl aside. Cover shredded cheese and let soften at room temperature for 3 hours. In mixer bowl combine softened cheese and remaining ingredients. Beat with electric mixer for 3 minutes, or until well combined. Fill reserved cheese shell with cheese spread. Serve with fruit and crackers. Can be made ahead, wrapped in plastic wrap and refrigerated. (Remove from fridge about 4 hours before serving. Makes 4 to 5 cups.
