Lieutenant John C. Fremont and his guide, Kit Carson, camped near the site of Lawrence, on June 12, 1842.

In his notes, Fremont wrote, "We encamped in a beautiful site on the

bluffs, which command a fine view of the Kansas river valley.

On the 14th, they crossed to the north side of the river, probably at the point where Topeka now stands.

On the 16th, Fremont says, "We are

now fairly into Indian country and we will begin to prepare for the chances of the wilderness."
