

NEWPORT, R.I. (AP) — James Blake's quest to become the first topseeded player to win the Hall of Fame Championships was in danger of ending until he found his rhythm in the final set and blew out Ota Fukarek.

Blake beat the Czech 7-6(3), 4-6, 6-1 to lead five Americans into the quarterfinals in the only grass-court tournament in this country. The others were Mardy Fish, Taylor Dent, Justin Gimelstob and Robby Ginepri.

BASTAD, Sweden (AP) — Topseeded Guillermo Canas scored the first shutout of the season on the ATP tour, beating Albert Montanes 6-0 6-0 to reach the quarterfinals of the Swedish Open.

The last time a player scored a "double bagel" in the Swedish Open was in 1978, when 11-time Grand Slam champion Bjorn Borg blanked Bob Carmichael in a second-round match.

GSTAAD, Switzerland (AP) – David Nalbandian, a surprise finalist at Wimbledon, won't be around for the end of the Swiss Open after losing in the first round 7-5, 6-3 to Andrei Pavel of Romania.

PALERMO, Sicily (AP) - Thirdseeded Asa Svensson of Sweden was upset by Lubomira Bacheva of Bulgaria 6-3, 6-3 in the second round of the Palermo International clay-court tournament.
