Henry Clay Davis, 91, died July 13, 2002 in Colby after a lengthy battle with Alzheimer's.

Services were held at 10:30 a.m. in the Colby United Methodist Church with the Rev. James Mardock officiating, burial followed in Beulah Cemetery.

Surviving are his wife, Joy; a son, Dan of Rock Hill, S.C.; daughters Diana Schiffner of Colby and Bette Albers of Oakley; a brother, Jack Davis of Grove, Okla.

He is also survived by six grandsons; four great-granddaughters; six great-grandsons; one step grandson and one step granddaughter.

He was preceded in death by his parents; three brothers, Alan, Rudy and Bob; and one great grandchild, Elijah Lampe.

He was born Nov. 4, 1910, in Pueblo, Colo., the second son of Rudolph and Ora Davis, and began school in Pueblo but when six years old moved with his family to Devine, Colo., and then to a farm near Nepesta, Colo., when he was seven where they raised beans and corn.

Due to his father's failing health, Mr. Davis' family moved to a farm near McPherson, when he was twelve years of age where he attended country school.

He missed several years of school to help on the farm. He later attended McPherson High School.

While going to high school, he worked some nights at the Hawley Hotel in McPherson. Following high school he worked at the Lassen Hotel in Wichita for three years before moving to Meade to manage the Lakeway Hotel.

While at Meade, he met Joy Irene Ford, whom he married September 14, 1942, in Amarillo, Texas, where he was working at the Herrington Hotel. Within a month of his marriage he was inducted into the United States Air Force. He served as a payroll clerk with the rank of Technical Sergeant.
