And speaking of good books, here are a few you might want to try. If you like novels with historical background the way I do, then you will want to check out *Smoke Filled Rooms* by Kris Nelscott. The time is 1968, the place is Chicago. Bill "Smokey" Dalton and 10-year-old Jimmy have fled Memphis for the Windy City.

Jimmy witnessed the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and knew that the killer was not the man the cops arrested that night. But once in Chicago, Smokey feels the danger is not over. The 1968 Democratic Convention is about to begin and he cannot shake the feeling that both he and Jimmy are being watched, along with the delegates. He knows Jimmy's life is still in danger.

Smoke Filled Rooms is a tale of lynch laws, stolen identities, kidnapping and the rise of consciousness of a wronged people, not to mention a thrilling mystery. It makes that period of history come alive in a whole new way.

"If I could tell you only one thing about my life it would be this. When I was seven years old the mailman ran over my head. As formative events go, nothing else comes close." Thus begins Brady Udall's book *The Miracle Life of Edgar Mint*.

Edgar, half-Apache and half-white, is, for all intents and purposes, an orphan. He survived that horrific accident and his smashed head was miraculously fixed. His life after that continued to be one "accident" after another. He spent a nightmarish time in a boarding school for Native American or-

phans, was taken in by a well-meaning but quirky foster family, and that's just the tip of the iceberg.

What really persists throughout the book, though, is Edgar's innate goodness - and his determination to find the mailman who thinks he killed him, and let him know that he is okay. The story is filled with heartache and hilarity and a very charming Edgar that you will cheer for all the way through the book. And by the way, you won't believe the surprise ending.

James Patterson has a new book out called *Beach House* which takes place in the trendy Hamptons. Jack Mullen, a law student, is devastated when he learns that his younger brother, Peter, drowned while working as a valet at a ritzy party.

Jack is not convinced that it was an accident. After all, he can't believe that his brother would go for a swim when he was supposed to be working, and what about all those bruises the coroner found on his body?

Jack is sure that the hosts of the party, who just also happen to be the parents of Jack's girlfriend, are covering up the truth about what happened to Peter. But why? *Beach House* like most of Patterson's books will keep

you turning pages quickly right up to the surprising conclusion.

Finally, I could write a review of this next book, *Mount Vernon Love Story: A Novel of George and Martha Washington* by Mary Higgins Clark, but I think I'll just quote the author: "Washington was a giant of a man in every way, starting with his physical height. In an era when men averaged 5'8", he towered over everyone at 6'3". I had always believed that he married an older woman, a widow, and that his true love was Sally Carey, his best friend's wife. The fact is that George and Martha loved each other deeply. Yes, she was older, but only three months." *Mount Vernon Love Story* is Ms Clark's first biographical novel and was originally published around 1968 under the title *Aspire to the Heavens*. According to the author, all the events, dates, scenes and people are based on verified historical research.

Adam Smith

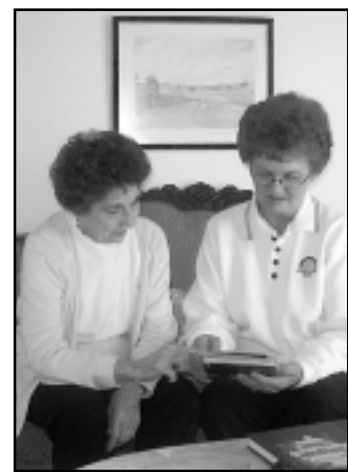

Lice problems can be controlled, official says

Those pesky old head lice have seemed to surface again. We have been seeing them come through the health department. How do you know if your child has them? If your child is itching their head, it isn't a bad idea for you to check them for head lice.

Have them sit in good lighting (even using a flashlight) and then look at their hair about 1/8 inch from their scalp on the hair itself.

You might see an egg (nit) which will look like a very tiny piece of rice "hooked" on to the hair and won't shake off (unlike dandruff).

It's very difficult to see the louse, but the nits are visible. If you find these in the hair, what do you do next? Contact the school or day care where your child has attended so they will know to notify other parents to be aware of this condition. Then purchase a lice ridding shampoo and follow the directions.

Most shampoos have you dry lather the shampoo on and leave on for 10 minutes. Just read and follow the directions. You will need to shampoo again in one week to make sure you kill the second hatching of the lice.

After you shampoo, condition and then "pick" out all the nits and dispose of them in the trash. The reason you pick out the nits is to make sure if their is a second hatching, you will notice new nits.

Then you will need to thoroughly vacuum your home and clean all clothing that your child has worn in hot soapy water and dry in the dryer. The furniture, carpet, and vehicles need to

all be vacuumed and place all stuffed animals in a bag for one week.

Lice need human hosts to live on. Don't forget to clean all hair wear, combs and brushes. Teach your children they shouldn't share any of these

items with their friends.

Having head lice doesn't mean you are "dirty" people, it is just a part of childhood. The most important thing you can do is to get control of these irritating bugs.
