Greg Schieber and Nathan Shyer, friends of the groom. The ring bearer was Tucker Gerstner, cousin of the bride.

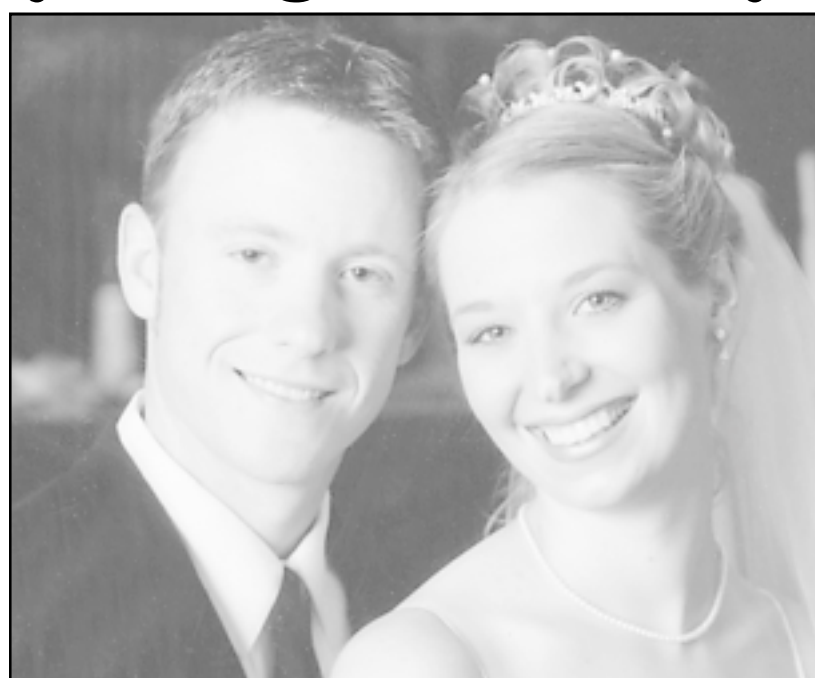
Guests were seated by Shawn Stockman, Jason Siemsen, cousins of the bride and Jonathan and Joshua Miley, brothers of the groom.

On Sept. 24, the Colby Rotarians met at the Ramada Inn. Guests for the day were Wayne Atkins, prospective member, Bob Mariner and Barrie Blout from England.

Brian Staats chair of Membership Committee announced that each team is to get one new member; this will help make the goal of ten new members by the end of the year.

Rotary History was the Object of Rotary. The object of Rotary is "to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise." This covers four areas by which "ideal service" is fostered.

One is through the development of acquaintances as the opportunity for service. Second is the promotion of high ethical standards in business and professions. given to the school.

The school moved to the Colby Plaza on the west side of town. The school also owns the old drive-in theater lots just north of the building. This will be for athletic and physical fitness programs.

The school took possession of the building in the year 2000. It has taken a lot of volunteer work and preparation so the school could open for this year. They had their Grand Opening on the 25th of August.

The school is run by basic beliefs in which they stand. The first is the fact they hold God's word as absolute. The second to be respectful of, honoring and obeying the laws of the land and to be quality and upright citizens.

"With this in mind, this will be our employment pull in the years to come. So we teach and educate our children to be faithful with positive work ethics," said Roberts.
