In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 2523 10, notice is hereby given that the books for registration of voters Thomas County will be open at the following place and time specified:

The County Clerk's office during regular office hours from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

At 5:00 P.M. on October 21, 2002 the books will close and remain closed for the voters of Thomas County until the day after the general election.

A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age and upwards, or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) of age at the next election, must register before he or she can vote. Voter registration books close 14 days before an election.

When a voter has been registered according to law their registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs:

- (1) The voter changes name by marriage, divorce or legal proceedings
- (2) The voter changes residence.
- (3) The voters name has been purged according to law.

If any of the above has occurred, you must re-register.

Any person may apply in person, by telephone, or by mail to the County Election Officer to be registered. Such application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.


