

USC beats Iowa 38-17 Orange Bowl

MIAMI (AP) - Heisman Trophy winner Carson Palmer played keep away from Brad Banks, and Southern California looked right at home playing in the Orange Bowl for the first time

Palmer dominated his duel with Heisman runner-up Banks, helping the No. 5 Trojans to a 16-minute advantage in time of possession as they beat third-ranked Iowa 38-17 Thursday night.

Palmer led scoring drives of 79, 80, 99, 85 and 61 yards, helping USC blow open a game that was 10all at halftime.

He threw for 303 yards and a touchdown and was chosen the game's most valuable player.

Banks was limited to 204 yards passing and failed to lead Iowa's normally high-powered offense into the end zone until the final

The Hawkeyes' biggest play came when C.J. Jones returned the opening kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown.

Southern California (11-2) beat a top 25 team for the seventh time this

USC won its final eight games and snapped a nine-gamewinning str eak by Iowa (11-2).

"We didn't think it would be this easy," said Mike Williams, who caught an 18-yard touchdown pass from Palmer.


