# Prairie Museum plans special box lunch event for Kansas Day

The Prairie Museum of Art and History is hosting three video lunches again this year in honor of Kansas Day.

A "Kansas Box Social" will start at noon at the museum with video showtime beginning at 12:15 p.m. The lunch dates are: Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday this week, said Judy Kleinsorge, education director.

The videos are Kansas-related programs. Showing on Tuesday is *Faces and Places of Southwest Kansas*, is another segment of the fast-paced tour of Kansas shown last year.

Award-winning journalists Larry Hatteberg and Steve Harper conduct a tour which includes the Red Hills, Medicine Lodge peace treaty pageant, Clark state fishing lake, St.

Jacob's well, Big Basin, Cimarron National Grassland, Lake Scott State Park and Monument Rocks.

On Wednesday, the video will be *Sunflower Journeys: Ft Dodge to Monument*.

This program is from the popular series produced by Topeka public television station KTWU. It aired in 1999 and covers Ft. Dodge, the post that once protected traffic on the Santa Fe Trail; George Washington Carver, the famous scientist who attended school in Minneapolis and farmed in Ness County; and the Nature Conservancy in Logan County and their effort to preserve the shortgrass prairie.

Thursday's program will be *Dodge City: The West in Crisis*. The town began as a headquarters for buffalo hunters — Buffalo City.

Later, as Dodge City, "Queen of the Cowtowns," it was host to cowboys and cattlemen. Though the title of the movie indicates a serious topic, it is a rather lighthearted look at the myths of the west.

"Last year was the first year that we held these lunches and they were very well attended," Kleinsorge said, "so we planned on doing it again this year."

The public is invited to attend this free program and may want to bring a sack (or box) lunch.
