The Colby Community College Trojan men's basketball team played cat-and-mouse with Garden City Wednesday night at the Community Building before pulling away late to win 80-70, improving to 19-5 overall and 6-4 in the Jayhawk West conference.

Colby opened the game on a 10-2 run and lead the entire game. Mike Wolters sparked Colby, hitting 4 three-point shots in the first half, as Colby led 41-27 at the break. Garden City cut the deficit to three on two occasions with just over 12 minutes left before Colby rallied for a 12 point lead with 5 minutes remaining.

The Trojans allowed a season high 24 offensive rebounds in the game, but did manage to grab 23 themselves, and Colby held the Region VI-leading field goal shooting team to 37.3 percent, while shooting 51.6 percent for the game.

Colby's Dedric Spooner had 20 points and 14 rebounds, EJ Drayton had 17 points and 6 rebounds, Jus-

tin Williams had 15 points and 9 rebounds, and Wolters finished with 12 points and 5 rebounds

Branden Miller had 6 assists, while Eric Fowlkes and Joseph Williams each collected 5 assists.

The Trojans travel to Concordia Saturday for a Jayhawk West game against Cloud County. Game time is set for 8 p.m.
