The Colby Heat recorded another win when they traveled to WaKeeneey on Monday and came back with a 16-0 win, and in the process watched pitcher Levi Schlick pitch a no-hitter.

Levi allowed no hits in the five innings pitched, and struck out 15 of the 19 batters he faced and gave up only 4 walks.

The team's bats were again slow to start with only one run scored in the first inning and one in the second.

Stephen Dinkel started off the third inning with a hit to left field, then scored off a single by Cory Sager. Eric Blanton walked and Treat Bugbee doubled to score Sager. Blanton and Bugbee both scored on a triple to center by Breck Arnberger. He was then able to steal home for the fifth run of the inning.

The Heat also scored five runs in the fourth frame. Tracer Hudson and Preston Kryzcki were both able to walk on base and steal their way around to score Heath Stephens walked and Dinkel was hit by a

pitch to board the bases. Both scored off a triple by Schlick, who then scored on a single by Sager.

In the fifth inning, the Heat added four runs with singles by Bugbee and Arnberger and doubles by Hudson and Kryzcki to end the game.

The B-team also won over WaKeeneey, 14-3. Kale Arnberger allowed no runs in the first three innings pitched and Brandon Rasmussen closed the final two innings allowing only three runs.

Rasmussen and Brent Arnberger each added two hits with Rasmussen scoring a run and Arnberger scoring two runs.

Thomas Wieland finished with one hit and two runs. Kale Arnberger and Jordan Voss each scored two runs and Ethan Stichel finished with one run.

Royals win again

CLEVELAND (AP) — Rookie Angel Berroa and Desi Relaford hit RBI singles in the 10th inning as the Kansas City Royals continued their recent domination of the AL Central.

Kansas City is 23-6 within the division and has gone 9-3 in its last 12.

The first-place Royals haven't been in first place this late in the season since 1987.

"We've been playing like a first-place team," manager Tony Pena said. "But we have a long way to go, and I don't want any of my guys to worry about what other teams are doing or other scores."

Raul Ibanez doubled off David Riske (1-1) to open Kansas City's 10th, and Michael Tucker sacrificed. With Cleveland's infield playing on the grass, Berroa lined a single over their heads into right.

After Carlos Febles reached on a two-out infield single, Relaford brought home Berroa.

Jason Gilfillan (1-1) pitched one

inning for the win and Mike MacDougal worked the 10th for his 18th save in 22 opportunities.

The Indians dropped to 1-7 against Kansas City this season, and are 1-8 in extra innings.

"They got us again," Indians starter Brian Anderson said. "We're going to have to figure out a way to beat these guys. They're in our division. Right now, they own us."

Anderson allowed one run and seven hits in eight innings, but came away with a tough no-decision when the Indians couldn't push a second run across.

They loaded the bases with one out in the eighth, but Royals reliever Jason Grimsley got Ben Broussard to hit into an inning-ending double play to keep it tied at 1.

The Indians played superb defense behind Anderson from the outset, but first baseman Broussard's wide throw to second helped the Royals tie it 1-1 in the eighth on Febles' bloop RBI single to right that hit the foul line.

Iowa State re-examines substance abuse policy

AMES, Iowa (AP) — The arrests of four Iowa State basketball players on alcohol and drug charges since February have prompted athletic officials to re-examine their substance abuse education program.

Athletic director Bruce Van De Velde said the university needs to do more in that area.

"We want it to be clear that we recognize we have a problem and we will meet this problem head-on," Van De Velde said Wednesday.

Van De Velde commented after point guard Tim Barnes was charged with drunken driving and possession of a substance believed

to be marijuana.

Barnes was arrested near the Iowa State campus early Tuesday, less than a month after starting forward Jackson Vroman was charged with marijuana possession in Spirit Lake.

Another starter, center Jared Homan, was charged with public intoxication in late March. Homan, 20, is not old enough to drink legally. In February, reserve Clint Varley was suspended for a game after being charged with drunken driving.

Iowa State coach Wayne Morgan has suspended Vroman and Barnes indefinitely.
