Neuheisel files suit against Washington

Washington football coach Rick Neuheisel sued the university and the NCAA, alleging he was wrongfully fired for participating in a college basketball gambling pool.

The lawsuit, filed in King County Superior Court, alleges the school fired him in an effort to avoid an NCAA investigation.

Neuheisel's lawyers filed the suit as audio tapes were released of his questioning by NCAA investigators. Neuheisel has claimed all along he was blindsided by the investigators, and the tapes certainly back up that contention.

The tapes, however, also support the university's position that Neuheisel initially lied about his involvement in a high-stakes NCAA basketball tournament gambling pool.
