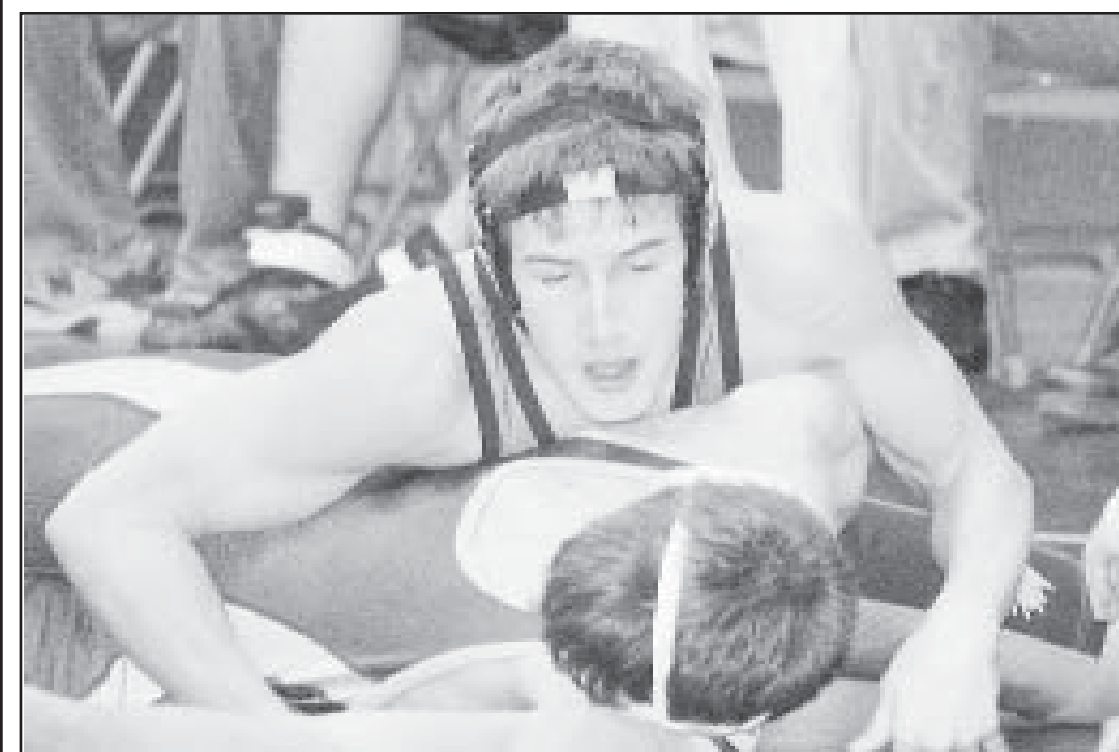


League tourney next stop

KU coach takes leave

LAWRENCE (AP) — Kansas women's coach Marian Washington said Thursday that she is taking a medical leave of absence, effective immediately.

In a news conference, Washington did not elaborate on the nature of her medical condition but said it has affected her for some time.

Athletic director Lew Perkins said the condition is not life-threatening.

"This year, it really started to become quite evident," Washington said. "This has been going on for a while. I talked to my doctors at the beginning of the season, but when you start reading about all these coaches taking some time, I thought immediately that I should do that."

Washington did not set a timetable for her return.

I have asked for two to three weeks," she said. "I will just have to find out how long it will take. Lew told me to take as much time as I need."

Perkins said assistant Lynette Woodard, a former standout player for the Jayhawks, would be the interim head coach.
