Debate continues about transportation's future

AP Political Writer TOPEKA (AP) — Discussions about transportation at the Statehouse this year have an almost panicky tone.

Many lawmakers and officials in Gov. Kathleen Sebelius' administration argue that the Legislature must act now to save the state's comprehensive transportation program from collapse.

Transportation Secretary Deb Miller has even promised to start canceling long-promised projects on July 1 if a transportation bill doesn't pass.

But the debate about Sebelius' proposal to float \$465 million in bonds is really more about the future of transportation policy. The Democratic governor's administration and Republican legislative leaders are pondering what happens in 2009, when the current program of highway, rail, airport and public transit improvements ends.

Department of Transportation projections suggest that, starting in 2009, the state won't have enough money even to sustain a full maintenance program. Congress is debating federal transportation spending and could provide additional funds, but officials aren't confident enough in any estimates to plug them into their projections.

What's clear is that in 2008 or 2009, legislators and the governor will have to consider starting another transportation program, one that involves raising taxes or issuing additional bonds. And that prospect complicates this year's discus-

"Down the line, how much are we going to cripple our ability to do another highway plan?" Rep. Gary Hayzlett, R-Lakin, chairman of the House Transportation Committee, said during a recent interview.

The state started its current program in 1999, promising \$13.5 billion over 10 years to transportation improvements. Legislators authorized bonds, increased motor fuels taxes and vehicle registration fees and agreed to set aside an evergrowing amount of sales tax revenues to complete a long and specific list of projects.

But governors and legislators have never dedicated the promised amount of sales tax revenues to the program, siphoning off at least a portion of the funds to other government programs. Under the current 2010 and \$592 million in 2011.

budget, the state diverted \$165 million and set aside no sales tax revenues for transportation.

The result is a gaping hole in funding for the program and Miller's threat to cancel \$550 million worth of projects over five

Under the 1999 legislation, the state is supposed to set aside 12 percent of its sales tax revenues to transportation. Sebelius proposes resuming the set-aside in 2006 but then only 3 percent of sales tax revenues, rising to 6 percent for 2008. Bonds would plug any remaining

Hayzlett wants the state to be more aggressive about resuming the set-aside. Sebelius and Miller argue that promising to set aside any more than 6 percent of the state's sales tax revenues is unrealistic and that Hayzlett's idea would not raise enough money, even if the state were to fulfill what it promises.

Hayzlett and other Republicans are looking for a compromise.

As for Sebelius' plan, Senate President Dave Kerr, R-Hutchinson said, "There are just issues everywhere regarding this thing."

Even without Sebelius' plan, bond payments backed by highway funds would jump from \$123 million to \$175 million in 2009. Her plan would add an additional \$35 million in bond payments, backed by general tax revenues.

Annual debt payments would remain at or near \$210 million until 2016, and that strikes Hayzlett and other legislators as too much of a burden. Under the 1999 program, the state was allowed to issue nearly \$1.3 billion in bonds — on top of \$890 million authorized for an eight-year program in 1989.

Miller said the debt load is manageable because part of the payments will come from general tax revenues.

"The same people who say, 'I'm concerned it's too much debt,' I don't think, are willing to cut projects, and I don't think they're willing to raise taxes," she said.

But KDOT faces future financial headaches even if Sebelius' program is approved.

For the budget that takes effect in 2009, KDOT figures show, the agency will have \$238 million less than it needs to sustain even basic, maintenance-heavy operations. The deficit rises to \$490 million in

Miller noted a projected deficit would exist even without Sebelius' plan. Also, she said, the state faced a similar situation in 1998, when the 1989 program ended, and legislators knew it would arise again eventually when they approved the 1999

program. But initial projections in 1999 showed the deficit occurring at least a year later. Kerr said Sebelius' administration is managing the current program so that "it just kind of crashes" when it ends.

"A follow-on plan will be nearly impossible," he said, speaking of the next potential transportation program.

Miller's biggest fear is that KDOT will have to cancel projects and will lose so much credibility that legislators will not want to pursue a new, post-2009 program. Doing nothing, raising too little money to bolster the program, or failing to deliver promised revenues in the near future all could cause her to cancel projects.
