United States remains vulnerable to a sophisticated al-Qaida organization ready to exploit security gaps, the commission investigating the attacks said in its final hearing

"Its intent to inflict harm is clear; the panel depicted the Federal Aviaintelligence on al-Qaida can and must improve," said Democratic vice chairman Lee Hamilton, a former representative from Indiana.
