

You can't afford to relax merely because the contract looks easy to make.

Take a case like this one, where you're in six hearts and West leads a club.

If you win with dummy's king and return a trump, as most declarers would do, you go down one.

West takes the ace, plays another club, East ruffs, and you wind up minus 100 instead of plus 1,630.

But if you're the worrying kind, you

make the contract. As soon as dummy comes down, you start fretting about what can happen to stop

you from making the slam. It wouldn't take you long to conclude

that the only real danger is the possibility of a club ruff. West's club lead, in the face of North's

It seems likely that he is either trying to get a club ruff for himself or trying to give one to his partner.

club bid, looks mighty suspicious.

Given these circumstances, you should look for a way to nip West's plan in the bud. Fortunately, if you study the situation, you find that something can be done.

Accordingly, at trick two you lead a spade to the ace, then cash the ace of diamonds and ruff a diamond in dummy.

Next you discard a club on the king of spades and lead a trump to force out the ace. Only at this point can you finally relax.

The deal demonstrates that a little worrying at the right time can do a lot of good. Tomorrow: Test your play.
