He was one of 120 young leaders representing high schools from all over the state, said Linda Niederklein, co-chair of the event. "Good leadership requires good decision making," she said. In turn, she added that good decisions require effort. The goal is in creating an interactive forum in which each student can learn about the free market process.

From there, they become better able to consider all options and then make informed decisions, and get a broader understanding of his or her leadership potential.

"This is what we teach," she said. This leadership seminar was established in 1958 by actor Hugh O'Brian, Niederklein said.

During a visit to Africa, he was inspired by a meeting with Dr. Albert Schweitzer.

"One of the things Schweitzer said to me was that the most important thing in education is to teach young people to think for themselves," O'Brian said in an interview years ago.

"From that inspiration and with the support of others who believe in youth and the American dream, I started the Hugh O'Brian Youth Leadership seminar to seek out and develop outstanding leadership potential among our nation's youth."

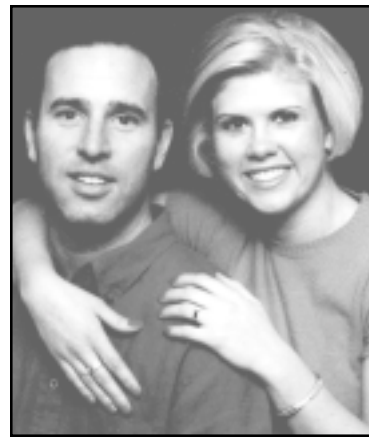
