Broncos' owner back in court

owner of the Denver Broncos who won a 1999 lawsuit seeking the right to buy a 10 percent stake in the team is fighting a proposal that would allow owner Pat Bowlen to buy the share back within two years.

During a court hearing Monday, attorneys for former owner Edgar Kaiser said the buy-back proposal would unfairly penalize him because he wouldn't be guaranteed fair market value for the stake when Bowlen buys it back.

DENVER (AP) — A former Matsch said he planned to rule before the end of the year. Both sides are expected to appeal, so Matsch said he would put his ruling on hold until the case is resolved. Any change in ownership of the team would have to be approved by the National Football League.

Kaiser sold a majority stake in the team to Bowlen in 1984 and sold the rest of his stake to Bowlen's family the following year. Kaiser alleged in a 1999 lawsuit that Bowlen violated a right-of-first-refusal provi-U.S. District Judge Richard sion in the sale agreement.




