sity researcher has found that producers who put more cattle than recommended on grassland early in the grazing season can boost beef production on a land area basis if the heaviest of those cattle are removed partway through the season.

"It sounds a little surprising," said Keith Harmoney, who is an assistant professor of range science at K-State's Agricultural Research Center at Hays. "The key is having a slightly greater stocking density while the grass is immature and actively growing, and then removing the heaviest animals during the last half of the grazing season."

The number of cattle that producers can turn out on grassland in Kansas is largely dependent on weather and range conditions and the weight of the animal to start with, but there are guidelines that producers can follow to best ensure the health of the animal and the health of the grazing land itself, said Kansas State University agronomist Walt Fick.


