

Two big 4A sub-state games on tap in Colby next week

The Class 4A Sub-State basketball tournaments roll in early next week, with two games scheduled at the Colby Community Building. On Monday at 7 p.m., the Colby High Eagle boys take on Ulysses. The Eagles are 11-9 on the season and Ulysses is 10-9. On Tuesday at 7 p.m., the Eagle Ladies meet up with Scott City. The Lady Eagles are 17-3 and Scott City is 1-18. The winners advance to the semifinals at Larned later in the week.
