• **Wins No. 880**
KNOXVILLE, Tenn. (AP) — Pat Summitt broke Dean Smith's career victory record, getting No. 880 in the Tennessee Lady Vols' 75-54 win over Purdue in the second round of the NCAA tournament. Summitt tied Smith with an easy win over Western Carolina in the first round Sunday night and passed the former North Carolina men's coach with another convincing victory. The 52-year-old Summitt improved to 880-171 in 31 years at Tennessee, while Smith was 879-254 when he retired in 1997 after 36 years with the Tar Heels.

• **Sidelined by broken bone**
MESA, Ariz. (AP) — Chicago Cubs reliever Joe Borowski will miss at least six weeks with a broken bone in his arm. Borowski was hit by a line drive in Monday's 12-5 loss to Kansas City. He was attempting to come back from a partially torn rotator cuff in his right

shoulder this spring. The injury ended his season last June.

• **Iverson fined \$10,000**
NEW YORK (AP) — Allen Iverson was fined \$10,000 by the NBA for a heated exchange the Philadelphia guard had with an official following the 76ers' loss to the Chicago Bulls on Saturday. Iverson, upset about calls, chal-

lenged referee Marc Davis after the 94-88 loss. Iverson had to be restrained by teammates. A few minutes later was seen heading in the direction of the referees' dressing room and the coach stopped him.
