Free Press Publisher Colby broadcaster Rich Epp was named "Sportscaster of the Year" by the Kansas Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association at their spring conference in Manhattan on March 19.

Athletic directors from across the state nominate sportscasters they feel are deserving of such recognition. A selection committee then listens to a two-minute tape of each nominated sportscaster and selects one to be the annual recipient.

Epp is the voice of the Colby Community College Trojans and the Colby High School Eagles.

He has an extensive resume and many awards that speak volumes of the respect he has earned over the years since beginning his career in broadcasting in 1971.

Epp was nominated by Terry Ostmeyer, activities director at the Grinnell School District.

"I have known Rich for years and our history goes back to when I played and he was sportscaster in this area," Ostmeyer said.

"Ostmeyer said Epp is respected, very active and recognizable in the communities all across northwest

'What strikes me most is how professional he always is and his impeccable appearance as he represents himself and his profession," Ostmeyer said.

"I take great pride in the fact that he was chosen for this award. There are many who are nominated each year and it is very nice to see the award given to a man that has devoted so much time and effort to the youth of northwest Kansas," he

Epp told the *Colby Free Press* today that "nothing gives me more pleasure than broadcasting high school athletic events, something I have been doing for 33 years.

"I've always enjoyed working with school officials in promoting the positive aspects of athletics."

Epp said that he is "grateful to the Kansas Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association for selecting me as Kansas Sportscaster of the Year."
