Good showing by track

The Colby Community College Trojan men’s track and field team finished third at the Alex Francis Relays in Hays on Saturday, behind Fort Hays State and Nebraska-Kearney.

Colby native Rocky Baalmann led the Trojans with a second place finish in the 200m and a third place finish in the 100m. His time of 11.02 in the 100m places him third on the Trojan’s all time list and his 200m time of 22.31 seats him at fourth.

Baalmann also was part of a 4x100m team that finished in third place with a time of 43.55, which is the second best effort in Trojan history. Other members of that relay team are Terry Verdun (Kenner, La.), Evan Kahle (Monument) and Tyler Sroufe (Holdrege, Neb.). Kahle finished fourth in the 400m with a time of 51.39, good enough for 10th all time at Colby College.

Sophomore Felipe Longoria (Scottsbluff, Neb.) also performed well at the event. He finished third in the 800m and then was part of two successful relay teams. The Trojan 4x800m team finished second with a time of 8:15.04. Running with Longoria were Derrick Monson (Lamar, Colo.), Dan Culver (Ulysses) and Carlan Arthur (Trinidad & Tobago). The SMR team (200, 200, 400, 800) team of Longoria, James Mason (Winston-Salem, N.C.), Jacob Falcon (Brewster) and Evan Kahle finished third with the third best time in Colby College history at 3:44.87.

The women’s side saw some good performances as well. Cassy Hamilton (Champion, Neb.) finished third in the shot put with a distance of 42’10 1/4”, which improved her national qualifier distance, and was the third best effort in Trojan history. Kim Crossland (Otis, Colo.) high jumped 4’11”, which placed her sixth at the event and eighth all time at Colby College.

Three Trojans also attended the Northern Colorado Heptathlon/Decathlon meet. Jenna Faimon (Stratton, Colo.) finished 15th and Marissa Thomas (Greeley, Colo.) finished 16th in the heptathlon. Clayton Bosserman (Oakley) finished 13th in the decathlon and hit the record books in three events. His shot put of 30’3” and his high jump of 5’3” placed him 10th all time at Colby College in both events. His final score of 4504 seats him at number eight in Colby College history.

Trojan baseball (4-8, 15-16) went 6-2 this week with decisive sweeps of Arapahoe (7-6, 12-5), McCook (12-1, 13-3) and Pratt (6-1, 11-1).

Softball coach Adams get his 500th win

Head softball coach Carl Adams recorded his 500th career victory over the weekend when the Colby Community College Lady Trojans defeated Kansas City, Kan. on Sunday morning, 3-2.

The Lady Trojans started their trip on Friday with a split at Brown Mackie, Salina. They won game one 7-6 in eight innings with the help of a 4 for 5 performance by freshman Molly Langerak. They lost game two 11-10 in nine innings despite freshman Heather Ebert

going 3 for 4 with a double, a home run and five RBI’s.

The Trojans opened the Johnson County tournament Saturday morning with a victory over Kirkwood, Iowa. Sophomore pitcher Corri Ball went 2 for 3 and had the game winning RBI.

The Lady Trojans picked up 10

hits in game two of the day against Johnson County, but lost 7-5. Then in game three, Molly Langerak went 3 for 5, but the Lady Trojans lost to Butler 12-8.

On Sunday morning the Trojans opened with a victory over Kansas City, Kan. 3-2, which provided Adams’ 500th career victory.

Sophomore Shanae Calkins went 3 for 3 and Corri Ball picked up the victory on the mound.

In the final game of the tournament the Lady Trojans lost to Indian Hills 9-1.

The Trojans (13-29) face Seward County (25-14) on Thursday in Liberal at 3 p.m. in a Region VI contest
