

Deadly holiday weekend on three lakes in Kansas

WICHITA (AP) — Three people were killed on Kansas lakes over the Fourth of July weekend, one of whose body was found Tuesday morning at Cheney Reservoir near Wichita.

Cheney State Park officials said Juan Ramirez Balbuena, 38, of Wichita, apparently was in his boat Sunday night when a violent storm swept through the area, causing so much damage that the park was closed for the Fourth of July.

Balbuena's boat was found capsized in about 3 feet of water, its ignition key still on. Reno County Sheriff Randy Henderson said his body was found at 10:45 a.m. Tuesday near the north end of the reservoir.

Saturday night, another Wichita man, 41-year-old Brian Schock, drowned after wading into El Dorado Lake to retrieve a child's

raft that had floated away. His body was found Sunday morning by divers in 14- to 16-foot-deep water after an overnight search.

Butler County Sheriff Craig Murphy said an autopsy showed Schock drowned. A toxicology report is expected back in a few weeks.

At Lake Wilson in Russell County, a Great Bend man was killed late Sunday afternoon in a crash involving personal watercraft.

The Russell County Sheriff's Office said Gary Gore, 54, was a passenger on a Jet Ski piloted by Vivian Harbaugh, 54, also of Great Bend, when the craft suddenly slowed and was struck from behind by a second Jet Ski, driven by Stuart Harbaugh, 25, of Wichita.

Gore, president of the Great Bend Chamber of Commerce, was killed

and Vivian Harbaugh was flown to a hospital in Kearney, Neb., where she had been discharged. Neither Stuart Harbaugh nor his passenger, 7-year-old Corey Harbaugh, of Great Bend, was injured in the crash.

At Cheney Reservoir, Schmidt said the lake and the park reopened Tuesday, though most services weren't expected to be back up until the end of the day. The park suffered extensive tree damage, he said, and inmates from the Hutchinson Correctional Center had been brought in to help with the cleanup. Schmidt said there were about 30,000 visitors in the park Sunday before the storm, and an additional 35,000 had been expected Monday. "This probably affected about 25 percent of our revenue for the weekend," he said.

Shrine Bowl players involved

MANHATTAN — When you look at the overall achievements and activities of players selected for the 2005 Kansas Shrine Bowl All-Star football game, you're left with one very strong impression: These players are not just one-dimensional athletes, whose lives focus only on football and other athletic endeavors.

The list of what the players have done outside of athletics is as impressive as it is long, and it starts with what they have accomplished in the classroom.

According to information supplied by the players, 14 of the 68 participants on this year's East and West squads have been inducted into the National Honor Society, a national organization that honors students for excellence in scholarship, leadership, service, and character.

Thirty-two have earned Honor Roll status at their respective high schools, and several have been honored for academic achievements.

Ten have been listed in Who's Who publications.

Dave Mize, Executive Director of the Kansas Shrine Bowl, says that's typical of the quality of the players chosen for the Shrine Bowl down through the years.

"There's no question that the athletes chosen to play in our game are players who have applied themselves on the practice field and in games over the years," he said.

"For many of them, those work habits have carried over into the classroom."

Many of the players are involved in their churches and communities.

More than a third of the players say they're involved in church or church-related activities, including youth groups, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, teaching Sunday School, going on church-sponsored mission trips, working in the nursery, singing in the choir, and participating in puppet and drama activities.

Several are volunteers for community youth activities, including coaching track and football, and assisting in football camps.

Mize says that Kansas can be proud of the abilities and character displayed by the Shrine Bowl Players. "Many are tomorrow's Kansas leaders," he said. "It's encouraging to be associated with them, because there's no doubt several will be among our business and professional leaders in just a few years."

The Kansas Shrine Bowl has been called the "Kansas Super Bowl of Hope." Proceeds from the game support the Shriner's Hospitals for Children, a network of 22

hospitals that provides expert, no-cost orthopedic and burn care to children under 18.

Reserved chairback tickets are \$20 in advance, \$22 on game night. Adult general admission tickets are \$9 in advance, \$10 on game night.

\$85 million deal

SEATTLE (AP) — All-Star guard Ray Allen agreed to a five-year, \$85 million contract extension with Seattle, his agent said. The contract includes \$80 million in salary and \$5 million in bonuses, although terms of the bonuses and the yearly breakdown of salary hasn't been determined. Allen became a free agent on July 1, and cannot sign the deal until the free-agent signing period begins on July 22. His agent, Lon Babby, said Allen plans to sign the contract at the first available moment. Allen will turn 30 on July 20.
