HOUSTON (AP) — The Missouri Tigers enter the 2005 season trying to deal with the death of one of their own.

Linebacker Aaron O'Neal died July 12 after collapsing following an hour-long voluntary workout with teammates. The cause of the 19-year-old's death has not been determined.

The seniors on the team have already chosen to dedicate the season to O'Neal's memory.

"That kind of changes everything," coach Gary Pinkel said at day two of Big 12 media days on Wednesday. "I think it's a little bit bigger and more important than it has ever been for obvious reasons."

Free safety Jason Simpson saidit other. is very important to him that O'Neal be honored and remembered.

"We don't want it to be that he didn't die for anything," he said. "He died on the field. He gave the ultimate sacrifice. ...he didn't hold anything back and I respect him for
