

Not realizing how badly everyone

had been affected, I left the house with only two small bottles of water, \$10 in cash and a few snacks. I wanted to leave everything for my husband — thinking that as soon as I got to Jackson, Miss., everything would be fine. I arrived in the town of Hazelhurst

on Tuesday evening with two thirsty, crying babies, and wondering what in the world to do. I pulled into the Days Inn and asked if they had a room. They did, but there was no water, no electricity and no drinking water. I left the front desk in

A kind Hispanic woman ran after me and offered me a gallon of her water. I offered her the \$10, but she refused it. Her husband told me I needed to stop and rest. She helped me take the kids out of the car. helped me with my luggage, helped me check in, and showed me to my room. Later that night, she brought me half a gallon of milk for the babies, and a beautiful votive candle so I could see them. She said, "For the babies."

We have worked hard to instill Thank you for helping me try to compassion and generosity in our daughter.


Furthermore, these comments can be especially hurtful to those who are physically unable to have more than one child.


