



Probability Becomes Certainty

Opening lead — queen of clubs.

In many cases where declarer starts out as a strong favorite to make his contract by adopting an obvious line of play, he can significantly improve on his chances by seeking an even better way to attain his goal.

For example, take this deal where South is in six hearts and West leads a club.

Declarer sees that the only real danger is the possibility of losing two spade tricks.

One way of playing the hand, after winning the club lead with the king, is to draw trumps, lead a spade from dummy and finesse the ten.

If this loses to the jack, declarer can win West's club or diamond return in dummy and try a second spade finesse by leading to the

In the actual deal, both finesses would lose and declarer would wind up down one — even though he was a 3-1 favorite to make the slam on this line of play.

However, a more cautious declarer would make the slam by adopting a different approach designed to overcome the possibility of West's holding the K-J of spades.

He would not settle for a 75 percent probability of success without first making an effort to raise his chances to 80, 90 or even 100 percent. This could be accomplished by an elimination play.

To reach the desired position, declarer would play as follows: king of clubs, ace of diamonds, diamond ruff, low heart to the nine, diamond ruff with the ace, ace of clubs, club ruff with the queen, low heart to the king.

This would reduce the dummy to three spades and the J-5 of trumps, while declarer has four spades and the ten of trumps.

A spade lead to the ten then destroys West. After he wins with the jack, he is forced to return a spade, a diamond or a club, and whichever he chooses, South scores the last four
