This procurement includes the fabrication, supply, delivery, start-up, demonstration and final certification of the proposed counter current aeration system. Work includes but is not necessarily limited to:

- A. Aeration and clarifier mechanisms complete with traveling bridge, diffuser assemblies, drives, scraper arms, scum removal system, baffling and all appurtenant aeration piping and electrical as shown on the drawings; and
