

Many people receive offers like the ones you mentioned and some of the best advice is to use caution when responding to a vacation package promotion.

Some travel opportunities offered through the mail, over the phone or by fax are legitimate, but many are scams that defraud consumers out of their hard-earned money each month.

Dear Kansas Consumer:

It can be difficult to tell a legitimate sales pitch from a fraudulent one but here are some tips on how

to protect yourself and your wallet:

• Be wary of low-priced offers and "great deals." Very few legitimate businesses can afford to give value or substantially undercut other company's prices.

• Do not allow yourself to be pressured into buying. If it is a good offer today it will usually be a good offer tomorrow.

 Ask specific questions. Make sure you determine exactly what the advertised price covers and what it does not. Ask about any additional charges, too. If the offer is a package deal, get the names of the hotel, airlines, and restaurants included,


