ORDINANCE NO. 1396

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 2-103 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS, PERTAINING TO QUALIFICATIONS OF AIRPORT BOARD MEMBERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS:

Chapter 2, Article 1, Airport Administration, Section 2-103, entitled MEMBERS; QUALIFICATIONS is hereby amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. AIRPORT ADMINISTRATION

2-103. MEMBERS; QUALIFICATIONS. The members of the board shall be qualified electors of the City of Colby or of Thomas County and the said board shall serve as a board of advisors for airport operations, maintenance, and development.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
