Law could hamper biodiesel plant

plant recently opened in downtown Burden, but a decades-old state law already has the owner worried about its future.

Grover McKee, who owns Salemby Industries, established the southeast Kansas plant with local farmer Patrick Dauber, after concluding that producers needed a way to drive up the value of their crops.

The plant uses canola, which produces a better oil yield than traditional sovbeans, to pump out about 500 gallons of biodiesel in an eighthour shift.

But a Kansas law that has been on the books since 1933 could force anybody who buys fuel from him to pay between \$1,000 and \$6,000 in bonds to the state highway fund.

The fuel McKee produces is pure biodiesel, B-100, which means farmers who want to use it must blend it with traditional diesel fuel. That act alone makes each farmer a manufacturer, subject to the same regulatory hurdles as other manufacturers, said state director of taxation Richard Cram.

"Unfortunately there isn't any exception in the licensing requirement," Cram said. "There's no minimum. You still have the same license and bond. I think that's the difficulty. Our statutes are pretty airtight on this."

Cram said the provision was put in place without considering very small producers and certainly with-

Fires burn 2 million acres

WICHITA (AP) - Major wild- Jim Schmidt, Butler County emerfires already have scorched more than 2.15 million acres across the nation so far this spring, setting the stage for what could be one of the worst fire seasons ever amid an escalating weather danger for fire, the National Interagency Fire Center said Tuesday.

On the front lines of the fire danger, fire departments in Kansas and elsewhere are straining under the load with little relief in sight from the windy, dry conditions.

Their mostly volunteer firefighters have been working 16hour days in-between their regular jobs. Firefighting equipment is breaking down under heavy use. Budgets have been decimated as high fuel costs and maintenance take a growing bite. And fears are growing that fire conditions are deteriorating as summer nears.

"We are seeing stuff that hasn't wide. happened in the last decade," said

BURDEN (AP) - A biodiesel out enough forethought to consider such modern breakthroughs as biodiesel. He also said the regulation isn't unique to Kansas and producers in other states will likely run into similar problems.

Still, McKee said he has spoken with several legislators about changing the statute

"I don't want to put my customers in peril for failing to comply with this goofy law," McKee said. "If state officials relax the law, it could be profitable to farmers."

Sen. Greta Goodwin, D-Winfield, said it was probably too late to introduce a bill for the 2006 session.

"I am interested in seeing what we can do for him," she said. "I think there is a drastic need for us to do something for small producers.'

McKee said Dauber might be able to use all the biodiesel produced this summer, but McKee wants other people to be able to buy the fuel.

He said he might move out of state or sell his equipment, although he would prefer neither.

"I'm not mad at anybody. I'm not outraged. The problem is, there are all kinds of crazy bureaucratic rules. I'm trying to see if there isn't a way this can't be resolved," McKee said.
