Supreme Court rehears Kansas death penalty case

WASHINGTON (AP) — Justice Samuel Alito was ready to play the role of tiebreaker as the Supreme Court heard arguments for a second time Tuesday in a case that considers the constitutionality of Kansas' death penalty law.

The court first heard arguments in the case on Dec. 7, but apparently justices were deadlocked after Justice Sandra Day O'Connor retired with a decision still pending.

O'Connor was a swing vote in a number of death penalty cases, sometimes joining the four more liberal members in throwing out

death sentences. Alito, who joined the court in January, asked several questions of both sides during oral arguments but did not indicate how he might

decide. The 1994 law says jurors must sentence a defendant to death if they find that factors for and against the death penalty are of equal weight. The state Supreme Court struck it

down, invalidating the death sentences of six convicted killers.

Kansas Attorney General Phill Kline said the law is valid because it does not stop jurors from deciding how much weight to give aggravating and mitigating circumstances in reaching a sentence.

"There is no chance in this case that the jurors weren't able to take the mitigating factors and give them whatever effect they wanted," Kline said.

Alito told Kline the law seems to death when jurors simply can't make up their minds.

Alito later asked Woodman whether defendants are better off under the Kansas statute because it offers jurors more flexibility to consider mitigating factors than sentencing laws in other states.

Justice David Souter offered the harshest criticism of the Kansas law: "We're on the fence, but execute anyway seems a total inconsistency," Souter told Kline.

But Justice Antonin Scalia said it death penalty laws. could make sense if put another way: "There is no mitigating evidence to outweigh those aggravating factors — that seems to me a 1170.

The case involves Michael Lee Marsh II, who was sentenced to death for the 1996 killings of Marry Ane Pusch and her 19-month-old act like a "default rule" in favor of daughter. Pusch was shot, stabbed and her throat slit. Then she was doused with lighter fluid and set on fire. Her daughter died from severe
