It didn't look great, but Colby advanced in regional play. Colby defeated Ulysses 10-7 Monday in the first round of regionals in Colby. The Eagles advanced to play Goodland today in the second round at Ulysses. "It was not a pretty win, but it was a win," said Colby coach Jack Elliott. "We had struggles with our

defense and pitching." Colby committed eight errors. Sarah Redmond, who has been Colby's better pitcher during the year, took the mound against Ulysses. She allowed four hits, struck out seven and walked two. But she didn't have the support behind her. Of Ulysses' seven runs, two were earned.

Ashley Barnes and Lauren Cox each had three hits to lead Colby. Barnes was 3-4 with a double, two RBIs and two runs scored. Cox was 3-4 with a run and an RBI. Katie Friesen, Leah Cox and Kristen Cox each hit a double. If Colby gets by Goodland, they will play in the championship game at 6:30 p.m.

## Eagle golf team heads to state

The timing was right for the Colby High boys golf team. Colby played second at the 4A regional meet Monday in Scott City to advance to the state golf meet. "It was the best meet of the year," said Colby coach Tom Bowen. "We were not the second best team on paper, but Monday we were." Colby shot a 322 led by Chris Staley's 74. Josh Johnson was second for Colby with an 80. R.J. Ladenberger shot a 82 and Cole Finley finished Colby's scoring with an 86. "We've been in the middle all year," Bowen said. "We've never

got over the hump." Ulysses won the meet with a 309. Ulysses' top four scores were 72, 76, 80 and 81. Following Colby was Pratt, 328; Thomas More Prep-Marian, 333; Goodland, 338; Scott City, 347; Russell, 362; Larned, 396 and Hugoton, 415. Bowen said he was impressed with Staley who has led the team this year. Bowen likes Staley's leadership with the underclassmen and those who have not played much golf. Kyle Molstad shot a 93 and Tanner Corder scored a 109. "He wanted to get the team to state," Bowen said.

The state meet is Monday at Wellington. Last year, Colby placed eighth at the state meet. In 2004, the team placed fifth. **League meet** Colby placed third at the Northwest Kansas League meet Friday in Hoxie. Colby shot a 336 and led by Staley with a 78. Oberlin won the meet with a 325 followed by Goodland with a 326. Other Colby scores include Johnson, 88; Ladenberger, 81; Finley, 89; Molstad, 98 and Corder 109.
