

Estate tax faces pivotal vote

WASHINGTON (AP) — Asked to choose between letting the estate tax live or die, senators geared up instead to decide whether to shrink taxes on inherited estates during this election year.

GOP leaders pushed senators toward ending the tax once and for all. It disappears in 2010, under President Bush's first tax cut, but rears up again a year later.

"Dying should not be a further burdensome, expensive and complicated event because of the death tax," said Sen. John Cornyn of Texas, one of many Republicans who want to see the tax evaporate.

Senate Majority Leader Bill Frist, R-Tenn., indicated that he wouldn't stand in the way of senators who might try to compromise and reduce the tax, should the effort at repealing it fall short.

The test comes Thursday with a pivotal vote that could put a bill repealing the tax onto the Senate's immediate agenda. The tax's critics need 60 votes to overcome the objections of many Democrats who want to leave the tax in place and who criticize the GOP for trying to

"The Republican Senate leadership is using up our legislative calendar to try to push through legis lation to assure that the very wealthiest estates will get a multimillion-dollar tax break," said Sen. Joe Lieberman, D-Conn.

According to the most recent statistics available from the Internal Revenue Service, 1.17 percent of people who died in 2002 left a taxable estate.

Sen. Jon Kyl, R-Ariz., who wants to see the tax disappear, has been trying to broker a compromise among Republicans and Democrats interested in paring down the tax. He said he was optimistic about chances for getting the bill on the agenda.
