Dallas takes 2-0 lead in finals

DALLAS (AP) — Jerry Stackhouse and Josh Howard led the Dallas Mavericks past the Miami Heat four points at a time.

Shaquille O'Neal managed just five points in the worst playoff game of his career.

Any way you add up those numbers, the marvelous Mavs are half-way to their first NBA title.

Stackhouse scored 19 points and Howard had 15 — and both converted four-point plays during the decisive runs in Dallas' 99-85 victory in Game 2 of the NBA finals on Sunday night, sending the Mavericks to Miami with a two-game lead.

Dirk Nowitzki's supporting cast made the biggest plays in this one-sided romp, but the German star shook off his Game 1 jitters to get 26 points and 16 rebounds for the Mavericks.

Game 3 is Tuesday night in Miami and a two-game deficit has only been overcome twice in NBA finals history.

Led by Stackhouse, Howard and Jason Terry, who had 16 points, Dallas' offense was effortless and exciting. The Mavs buried the disorganized Heat with waves of

points that included a 27-6 run in the second quarter.

"We had to push tempo a little more," Stackhouse said. "We got some 3s to go down in the second half, and our defense got going along with our offense."

Both Stackhouse and Howard even converted four-point plays — the elusive act of hitting 3-pointers while getting fouled. There were just six four-point plays in NBA finals history before the game, and Dallas was the first team ever to get two in the same game.

But the Mavericks did something much more historic and important on the other end: They limited O'Neal, the three-time NBA MVP with five previous trips to the series, to the fewest points in his playoff career. In 190 career playoff games, Shaq finished with a single-digit point total just three times.

"It was a team effort," Nowitzki said. "No one can stop Shaq one-on-one. It was a team effort, and our big men did a decent job."

O'Neal scored on the Heat's very first possession while being fouled, but he missed the ensuing free

throw — and then went 20 1/2 minutes without another basket. Shaq's frustration grew with every possession, contributing to his 1-of-7 free throw shooting after going 1-for-9 in the opener.

O'Neal, who was 2-for-5 from the field — both career playoff lows — spent the final 15 minutes on the bench after Dallas went ahead by 25 points.

Dwyane Wade scored 16 of his 23 points after halftime on 6-of-19 shooting, and was almost as invisible as his bigger teammate for long stretches against Howard's defense. Antoine Walker scored 20 points, hitting four 3-pointers.

Miami trimmed the lead to 12 points in the final minutes with Alonzo Mourning in the middle, but Nowitzki carried Dallas to another festive finish after a 90-80 victory in Game 1.

Only Boston (1969) and Portland (1977) have rallied from an 0-2 deficit to win the finals. Unless the Heat figure out a solution to the group malaise that's left Wade on the perimeter and kept the ball away from O'Neal, their season will be over in a few days.

It's game on at the Stanley Cup

EDMONTON, Alberta (AP) — The Carolina Hurricanes are tired of talking about Ryan Smyth's disputed goal.

Sure, they're still a bit ticked that Smyth's winning score in Game 3 of the Stanley Cup finals was allowed to stand even though he was in the crease and may have interfered with goalie Cam Ward.

No use worrying about it now. There's another game to play, another chance to take a commanding lead in the series.

"It's over," left winger Cory Stillman said after the Hurricanes practiced Sunday. "If we keep dwelling on that, we're in trouble. It happened. They won the game. They deserved to win the game."

Smyth's goal with just over two

minutes remaining gave the Oilers a 2-1 win and reduced Carolina's lead in the series to the same margin.

Game 4 is tonight. If the Hurricanes can pull off the first road win of the series, they'll return to Tobacco Road with a chance to wrap up the championship two nights later.

From the Hurricanes' point of view, Ward didn't really have a chance to cover the puck because Smyth was in the crease.

With the clock winding down and overtime looming, Edmonton's Alex Hemsky got off a shot from the right circle that was blocked by Ward. The rookie goalie couldn't control the rebound, however, and Smyth crashed the net looking to get

a piece of the puck, a trademark play for the rugged forward who's known for scoring ugly goals.

At that point, things get a little fuzzy. Ward swiped at the puck, which appeared to bounce off Smyth's chest and may have caught the shaft of his stick as well. Somehow, it got under the fallen Ward and slowly crossed the line, just inside the right post.

When referee Paul Devorski gave the signal for a goal from behind the net, Smyth was clearly in the crease and hovering above Ward, who took a whack at the Edmonton player's legs out of frustration.

Royals record triple play

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (AP) — Not even a bizarre triple play could save the Kansas City Royals from the Tampa Bay Devil Rays' home run barrage.

The Royals turned a triple play with the help of an appeal in the second inning, but could not overcome the Devil Rays, who hit matched their club record with the six homers in an 8-2 win on Sunday.

With Aubrey Huff on third and Rocco Baldelli on first, Russell Bryan fled out to David DeJesus in shallow center. Huff came home on the play.

Baldelli attempted to take second on the throw home, but was thrown out by pitcher Scott Elarton (1-8), who was backing up the throw to the plate.

Angel Berroa tagged out Baldelli and then threw to Mark Teahen at third base as the Royals claimed Huff had left early.

Third base umpire Bob Davidson agreed with the appeal and ruled Huff out.

"He (Huff) left a step early,"

Teahen said. "It wasn't even close. He definitely left early."

Huff disagreed. "I didn't realize that was a triple play," Huff said. "That's how unimpressive that was. It's a joke. You've got to make sure, it has to really be obvious. It cost Brayan a RBI."

It was the Royals' first triple play since April 3, 1996 at Baltimore. It was the sixth triple play in Royals history.

"The triple play was the highlight of my day," Elarton said. "That's pretty sad. That's about the only good thing that happened today."

Devil Rays manager Joe Maddon argued with Davidson, but to no avail.

"Huff didn't do anything wrong," Maddon said. "He tagged appropriately and did not leave early. That triple play totally stands out because of the uniqueness. I can't imagine there has ever been a triple play like that with that combination of numbers (8-1-6-5 in the scorebook)."
