NOTICE OF PLACES AND DATES FOR REGISTRATION

In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2310, notice is hereby given that the books for registration of voters of Thomas County will be open at the following places and time specified:

The County Clerk's office of Thomas County during regular office hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

At 5:00 p.m. on JULY 17th 2006, the books will close and remain closed for the voters of Thomas County until the day after the Primary Election.

A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age and upwards, or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) years of age at the next election, must register before he or she can vote. Voter registration books close fourteen (14) days before an election.

When a voter has been registered according to law their registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs:

- (1) The voter changes name by marriage, divorce or legal proceedings.
- (2) The voter changes residence.
- (3) The voters name has been purged according to law.

If any of the above has occurred, you must re-register.

Any person may apply in person, by telephone, or by mail to the County Election Officer of Thomas County to be registered. The applicant under penalty of perjury shall sign such application.
