### ORDINANCE NO. 290

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BREWSTER, KANSAS INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE," AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 286.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BREWSTER, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE. Section 11-101 of the Code of the City of Brewster, Kansas 1995, is hereby amended to read as follows:

INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Brewster, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2006, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three (3) copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 290," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

SECTION TWO. REPEAL. Ordinance No. 286 is hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication once in the official City newspaper.

### ORDINANCE 293

AN ORDINANCE ATTESTING TO AN INCREASE IN TAX REVENUES FOR BUDGET YEAR 2007 FOR THE CITY OF BREWSTER.

WHEREAS, the City of Brewster must continue to provide services to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of this community; and

WHEREAS, the cost of providing essential services to the citizens of the city continues to increase.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Brewster:

Section One. In accordance with state law, the City of Brewster has scheduled a public hearing and has prepared the proposed budget necessary to fund city services from January 1, 2007 until December 31, 2007.

Section Two. After careful public deliberations, the governing body has determined that in order to maintain the public services that are essential for the citizens of this city, it will be necessary to budget property tax revenues in an amount exceeding the levy in the 2006 budget.

Section Three. This ordinance shall take effect after publication once in the official city newspaper.

### ORDINANCE NO. 291

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14-101 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BREWSTER, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2006, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 285.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BREWSTER, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE: Section 14-101 of the Code of the City of Brewster, Kansas, 1995 is hereby amended to read as follows:

INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating within the corporate limits of the City of Brewster, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2006, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three (3) copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 291," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

SECTION TWO. TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS AND TRAFFIC OFFENSES.

- (a) An ordinance traffic infraction is a violation of any section of the Ordinance that prescribes or requires the same behavior as that prescribed or required by a statutory provision that is classified as a traffic infraction in K.S.A. 8-2118.
- (b) All traffic violations which are included within this Ordinance, and which are not ordinance traffic infractions, as defined in subsection (e) of this section, shall be considered traffic offenses.

SECTION THREE. PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES. The fine for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or any other traffic offense for which the municipal judge establishes a fine in a fine schedule shall not be less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00, except for speeding which shall not be less than \$10.00 or more than \$200.00. A person tried and convicted for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or other traffic offense for which a fine has been established in a schedule of fines shall pay a fine fixed by the court not to exceed \$500.00.

SECTION FOUR. REPEAL. Ordinance No. 285 is hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the official City newspaper as provided by law.
