Parents should consider college student's health insurance needs

As the fall semester approaches, college students and their parents should think carefully about the students' ongoing health insurance needs. A serious illness or injury could lead to catastrophic consequences for a college student without health insurance.

Coverage Through a Parent's Health Insurance Policy

The good news is that most individual and group health insurance policies cover dependents, who are full-time students, until the age of 23. Companies may have different definitions of a full-time student and the maximum age of coverage so check with your health insurer about how the policy defines a fulltime student and the maximum age of coverage.

An area hospital administrator is advising people to protect themselves against West Nile virus.

"West Nile virus occurs in the late summer and early fall months," Logan County Hospital Administrator Kyle Hahn said. "The Kansas Department of Health and Environment recommends that Kansans take the following actions to protect themselves and family members." Hahn using insect repellent with picaridin, otherwise known as DEET, on exposed skin, along with wearing clothing with long sleeves and pant legs will help protect against the virus.
