BAXTER SPRINGS (AP) -The Baxter Spring Historical Society has received a grant to turn a gas station along historic Route 66 in southeast Kansas into a welcome center for the famed high-

The National Park Service Route 66 Corridor Preservation Program awarded the society a \$26,202 grant to restore the gas station's exterior and provide heating and air condition. The Baxter Springs Historical Society, which owns the building, plans to match the grant with money or with inkind labor.

"Kansas is a real important spot along the route," said Mike Taylor, director of the Route 66 Corridor Preservation Program. "Even though there's a short length of the highway in the state, it's really full of some wonderful, historic properties.

Norman, Okla., who has restored several Phillips 66 stations, said they began as unattractive tin shacks. But by the 1930s, the company began designing the stations to blend into neighborhoods.

"They painted them in pretty garish colors," Kertok said. "The original color was emerald green with orange and blue trim, with roof shingles of all three colors in a random pattern.'

Kertok said pictures he has seen of the gas station in Baxter Springs don't conform to the classic design and that the builder may have taken liberties with the company's plans.
