The next meeting will be on Tuesday, Sept. 12 at South Wind Plaza. Carpenter will be both hostess and program chairman.

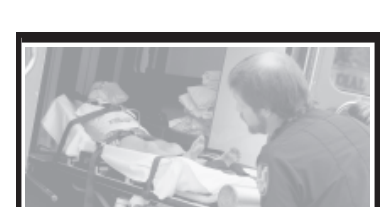
