

Colby Eagle runners place fifth at Lakin

The entire Colby High cross country team competed in the same meet Saturday at Lakin. The team was divided into four separate divisions. For scoring purposes, the boys and girls places from each divisions were combined using the top seven places overall. Colby placed fifth with 72 points. 


