Lead poisoning has lasting impact

The effects of lead poisoning in children have both a physical and a mental impact. Lead has not been an ingredient in house paint in the Deficit Disorder, such as being eas-United States since 1978, but the danger of lead poisoning in children is still very real. Parents are always going to worry about their children and the modern world seems to give us something new to worry about on an almost daily basis.

Although lead exposure is dangerous at any age, it is particularly dangerous for children three years of age or younger because during child's growth, the brain is developnerve connections may be damaged by lead or may not even form prop-

In addition to obvious physical health problems, lead poisoning in children may lead to lower IQs or mental retardation. Brain damage at such an early age can also cause behavioral problems such as in-
