

# Stuck between a rock and Kansas



Students from Colby and library staff looked at a pagoda at the Garden of Eden in Lucas during a geology-themed field trip Saturday. The field trip included stops at Mushroom Rocks near Brookville and Rock City.

Pioneer Memorial Library's program titled "Library in Motion" was off and running again last weekend.

We "Rock N' Rolled" through the state and visited some of the great rock attractions across Kansas. A big thank you goes out to the Thomas County Sheriff Law Enforcement Fund and the Friends of Pioneer Memorial Library for making this trip possible.

We started off with a visit to Rock City. Rock City consists of a large group of spherical rock formations (about two football fields) just outside of Minneapolis. This is the largest concentration of this type of rock formation in the world. We came, we saw, we scaled, and we conquered.

Next, we set off for Mushroom Rocks near Brookville. These rocks are aptly named for their resemblance in appearance to a mushroom. Most scientists agree that these rocks were formed by erosion. However, a more unlikely possibility is that these are large petrified mushrooms leftover from the Jurassic Age.

have made us hungry as our next stop was the restaurant *Made from Scratch* in Wilson. Our lunch was befitting to the occasion; we were served bierocks (get it!).

With full stomachs we headed to our next destination: the Garden of Eden in Lucas. Mr. Dinsmoor was an unusual man to say the least. He was a grassroots artist in concrete sculpture. His house is a "log cabin" made with post rock "logs" and chinked with concrete. His yard is filled with concrete sculptures symbolizing his religious and populist beliefs.

One of the more intriguing and morbidly entertaining parts of the Garden of Eden was Mr. Dinsmoor's tomb. Mr. Dinsmoor wanted his life and work to be perpetual. Thus, his body is still on display today (as it has been since 1932) to be viewed by the public. The picture you see above is the tomb Mr. Dinsmoor created where he and his first wife are buried.

Finally, we ended our tour with a visit to Pete Felton's gallery in Hays. If you are not familiar with Mr. Felton's work, he is the sculptor that created, among other things,

the Pteranodon along Interstate 70 (just east of Hays) and the buffalo that stands outside the courthouse in Atwood. Pete gave us a great demonstration of what he creates and how it is created.

Overall, I can safely say that this trip rocked!

## Economist wins Nobel Peace Prize

OSLO, Norway (AP) — Bangladeshi economist Muhammad Yunus and the bank he founded won the Nobel Peace Prize on Friday for pioneering the use of microcredit, the extension of small loans to benefit poor entrepreneurs.

Grameen Bank has been instrumental in helping millions of poor Bangladeshis, many of them women, improve their standard of living by letting them borrow tiny

sums to start businesses. Loans go toward buying items such as cows to start a dairy, chickens for an egg business, or cell phones to start businesses where villagers who have no access to phones pay a small fee to make calls.

"Lasting peace can not be achieved unless large population groups find ways in which to break out of poverty," the Nobel Commit-

tee said.

Yunus said the award was "great news" for his homeland.

"I am so so happy," Yunus told The Associated Press when reached by telephone.
