

Trojans win Pratt Tournament

The Colby Community College volleyball team won two games Friday and one on Saturday to take first place at the Pratt Invitational Tournament. The Lady Trojans defeated NOC-Enid (30-18, 30-20, 30-19) and Kansas Wesleyan JV (30-16, 30-16, 30-17) on Friday, and defeated Cloud County (30-21, 30-28, 30-20) on Saturday.

Ana Kokanovic and Cynthia Danthon were named to the All-Tournament Team, and Colby coach Pedro Gonzalez was pleased at his team's total effort.

"The whole team contributed in

a big way," Gonzalez said. "Our blocking game is becoming a factor and we are a different team from the beginning of the season. The coaching staff is very happy with the team's performance, especially the fact that we played consistent from the opening serve to the conclusion of the every match."

Sophomore outside hitter Ana Kokanovic (Serbia) had 17 kills, five blocks, nine aces and 16 digs. Cynthia Danthon (Combs la Ville, France, sophomore) had 14 kills, 16 blocks, five aces and 10 digs. Vicmari Prospero (Santurce, Puerto

Rico freshman) had six kills, seven blocks and 10 digs. Milica Micovic (Serbia freshman) contributed five kills, 12 blocks and 39 assists.

Gonzalez said the Lady Trojans did an excellent job against Kansas Wesleyan of moving the sets around and taking some of the burden off by setting Kokanovic every time.

"Every team knows that (Ana) is the one to watch," Gonzalez said. "But, we have several other weapons on the team that are capable of producing."

Colby plays 6:30 p.m. Wednesday at Cloud County.

Oberlin takes league tourney

25, 26-28. Colby lost to Oberlin 19-25, 17-25

"We played so much better this weekend. We just need to make fewer unforced errors at the net," Wagoner said. Colby plays in substate 2 p.m. Saturday at the Max Jones Field House in Goodland.
