The Lady Trojan team of 2006-07 has many new faces.

"With a new team, it takes some time to find out all the tools that this team will have and how they will all be put together," said coach Tom Stephens. "We want to improve every day, be able to sustain effort every day, and get better every day." Last year's team finished the regular season 27-3 and played in the national tournament, the first in school history. A few players remain from that team.

Three returning players are Jamie Schroeder, Loree Siruta and Jacci Tinkler. Stephens said Schroeder, a 5-9 "blue collar" player, does well on both ends of the floor. "Jamie has always will give it her all on the floor."

Siruta will play multiple positions. "She is tough as nails and that will be needed from her this year," Stephens said.

Tinkler will be expected to exert herself more this year. "Jacci is a smart player and will be more comfortable with a year under her belt. Jacci can play 1 and 2 equally well."

Newcomers include: Zivile Gaizutyte, Erin Goodhue, Katie Joens, Shanice Johnson, Courtney Primmer, Ingrid Pudliner, Sandra Sormaz, Tamara Thomas, and Vanja Zelenovic.

Gaizutyte is 6-2 from Lithuania. Stephens said she is a versatile inside-outside threat. She had an ACL injury and will be rehabbing this year. Goodhue, 5'11" is from Calhan, Colo. Goodhue can play multiple positions, which will make her a tough match up for our opponents.

Joens, 5-7 is from Leawood. "She thrives on the challenge of playing against great competition. She is

Colby loses first one

The Colby Community College Lady Trojan basketball team dropped its season opener Thursday 46-76 in Levelland, Texas, to No. 15 ranked South Plains.

South Plains jumped out early and had a 42-22 halftime lead. The Lady Trojans struggled with turnovers, committing 33 on the night.

Jacci Tinkler, a Topeka freshman, led the Lady Trojans with 14 points. Tinkler connected on 3-6

three-point attempts and was 5-6 from the free-throw line. Katie Joens, an Overland Park freshman, added 13 points.

Overall, Colby shot 34 percent from the floor and connected on just 7-28 attempts from three-point range.

The Lady Trojans return to action 5 p.m. tonight at the South Plains Tournament against Northern Oklahoma.

with," Stephens said.

New era arrives at Kansas State

MANHATTAN (AP) — The buzz began building the day Kansas State's coaching job came open. Bob Huggins, so the rumor went, was interested.

Skeptics wondered why Huggins had taken Cincinnati to 14 straight NCAA tournaments — including one Final Four — in 16 years. He would want a team that hadn't made the NCAA field since 1996?

Now, however, questions have less to do with whether Huggins can get the Wildcats back into the postseason than how deep a run they can make.

That's why almost 10,000 fans waited in line to watch a late-night scrimmage. It's why almost 13,000 season tickets have been sold for an arena that seats 13,500.

"When you bring a coach in that is proven, and the players don't question what he says, people just go with the flow and it definitely excites us," junior swingman David Hoskins said. "Coach Huggins brings a lot more intensity to us, and it has helped."

Huggins, who spent a year assembling a high-powered recruiting class after being fired at Cincinnati in 2005, has done little to curb the enthusiasm.

At the "Madness in Manhattan" event, he promised that the Wildcats would snap a 23-game home losing streak to Kansas and speculated that the Wildcats' new third uniforms — the black ones with the purple claw markings down the side — would look good in a Big 12 tournament

final or an NCAA regional semifinal.

"They know I'm not real good about being second, and I'm miserable when we lose," Huggins said. "I think they understand that and I think they're kind of the same way. They're starting to develop that attitude."

Whether the Wildcats can translate that attitude into victories remains to be seen. But Huggins does have several proven playmakers on hand and a load of promising newcomers.

Senior swingman Cartier Martin

is the top returning player — once Huggins let him back on the team, that is.

Martin led the Wildcats with 18 points and 6.6 rebounds last season, but was suspended by Huggins in May for an unspecified violation of team rules. Huggins didn't reinstate him until the start of practice in October.
