ern corners of the Panhandle. Landowners who join the effort must allow periodic monitoring of their property.

"If you optimize the rangeland, it's good for everything," said Anderson, who also raises cattle.

Conserving the prairie chicken's habitat has the additional benefit of nurturing grasslands for other species, such as the pronghorn antelopes, said Heather Whitlaw, a parks and wildlife biologist in Lub-

"It's a wonderful tool," she said. "I hope that our landowners will see that this is a win-win for them."
