

Golden Plains teams, Brewster boys win games

Golden Plains girl's basketball team defeated Stratton, Colo., 70-37 Tuesday in the first round of the Sagebrush Tournament held in Brewster.

Golden Plains led by 12 after the first quarter and extended the lead to 24 at the beginning of the fourth quarter.

Four players scored in double digits for Golden Plains. Katy Spresser led with 24.

Liz Staats and Kendra Spresser each had 13. Britt Ritter scored 12. Stratton only shot 31 percent (17-54) from the field. Golden Plains shot 45 percent (25-56) from the field.

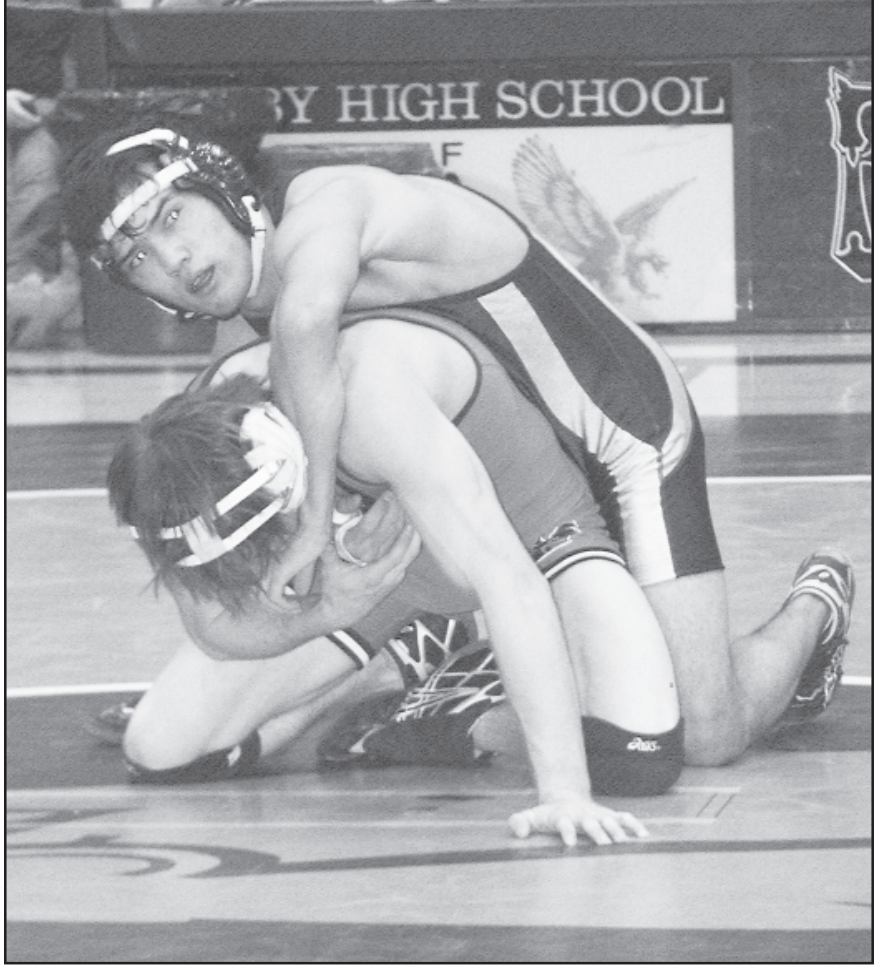
Golden Plains will play Saint Francis 8 p.m. Friday in the semifinal round. Saint Francis defeated Idalia, Colo., 76-49.
