Trojans begin Jayhawk play with different results

The Colby Community College men's basketball team couldn't protect a four-point lead at halftime lead and lost 77-87 at Garden City Wednesday night.

It was the first game in Jayhawk Conference play for Colby. Statistics were not available by press time today.

The loss dropped the Trojans record to 6-9 overall and 0-1 in the conference.

Chiefs quarterback hobbled

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (AP) — A sore ankle limited Trent Green in practice Wednesday amid signs that Kansas City coach Herm Edwards may have his struggling quarterback on a short leash.

Green, who committed three turnovers and got booed in Sunday's playoff-clinching victory over Jacksonville, is still slated to start Saturday at Indianapolis.

But waiting in the wings is fan favorite Damon Huard, who was an impressive 5-3 in eight starts while Green recuperated from a severe concussion sustained in the season opener.

"I anticipate (Green) starting," Edwards said Wednesday. "But we'll see how far he comes along tomorrow."

Since returning against Oakland on Nov. 19, Green has looked neither as sharp nor as consistent as the quarterback who from 2001-05 passed for more yards (16,334) than anyone in the NFL but the Colts' Peyton Manning.

He has thrown nine interceptions and seven touchdown passes and has been sacked 24 times.

His poor quarterback rating of 74.1 is dwarfed by the 98.0 of Huard, who threw 11 TDs and only one interception while subbing for him.

Green came out of the Jacksonville game briefly with an ankle injury and watched Huard march the offense downfield to a quick touchdown, setting up the score with a beautifully thrown 40-yard gainer to wide receiver Eddie Kennison.

Edwards said Green did not do any team work on Wednesday.

"It's sore, I know that," he said of Green's ankle. "We'll see tomorrow."

A quarterback controversy has simmered for two months, with a growing number of fans and media members climbing on board the Huard bandwagon. Edwards seemed to give encouragement to that faction on Tuesday when he admitted that he would be more inclined to replace a struggling player in the playoffs than he would in the regular season.

clined to replace a struggling player in the playoffs than he would in the regular season.

"You have to win the game," Edwards said. "There's no tomorrow. And you have to do whatever is best for the football team at that point. I'll do whatever I have to do. When you're in the playoffs, you're desperate."

Green said Wednesday he's not looking over his shoulder.

"I'm more worried about the Colts defense and trying to get as healthy as I can for this game," he said. "I've taken some shots the last few weeks and am trying to get as healthy as I can and worry about the Colts defense. Whatever everybody else is saying or whatever decisions are being made, the Colts are my main focus."

Told that he would be giving hope to the anti-Green clamor, Edwards became defensive.

"People will think whatever they want to think," he said. "At the end of the day, I make the decisions."

Xavier spoils Kansas State

CINCINNATI (AP) — Disappointed by Xavier's recent effort, coach Sean Miller ramped up the intensity of practice and started screaming when things went wrong during games.

Turns out that there's a little bit of Bob Huggins in him.

With Miller screaming from the sideline, Stanley Burrell scored 23 points and led a first-half run Wednesday night that sent Xavier to a 76-66 victory over Kansas State, spoiling Huggins' homecoming.

Xavier (10-4) has gone 4-3 since it briefly moved into the Top 25 last month, a stretch that coincided with Burrell's shooting slump. The junior shooting guard has struggled to put together a stretch of solid games.

The Musketeers got a solid all-around effort a few hours after Miller screamed at his team for a lethargic morning workout.

"Coach has stepped it up to another level," said Burrell, who made all of his 10 free throws. "We didn't go hard at the shoot-around this morning, and he went crazy. He was like, 'I'm not having this.'"

Miller has decided that his team, which is led by a group of quiet personalities, needs to develop an edge. The Musketeers' heart has been questioned during their early struggles.

"It's not fun when you get called soft," Miller said. "I don't know if there's a worse thing they can call

you. Our team understands we've been labeled that, whether right or wrong. In the last two games, it would be tough to call our team soft."

Told that he sounds a little more like Huggins lately, Miller said, "I don't know if that's good or not."

For Huggins, there wasn't much good after the pregame introductions.

The Wildcats couldn't contain Burrell, who led a 15-2 spurt that put Xavier up by double-digits in the first half. Burrell's perfect night at the free-throw line also prevented Kansas State (10-4) from catching up.

"The reality is, we're very limited," Huggins said. "We don't shoot it very well, we don't pass it very well."

Huggins returned to the city where he built his career — and a nationally prominent program — during 16 seasons at Cincinnati. He was forced out by the school president before the start of last season, but stayed in town until he took the job at Kansas State in March.

During his stint at Cincinnati, some of his most vexing losses came against Xavier, the Bearcats' crosstown rival. Xavier went 8-8 against Huggins' teams and won six of the last nine in their series.

One of Huggins' most painful losses came against Xavier on the Bearcats' home court, a 71-69 defeat at the start of the 1996-97 season when Cincinnati was ranked No. 1.

Huggins got the loudest cheers — and loudest boos — during pregame introductions at the off-campus arena, where Cincinnati and Xavier play occasionally. Thousands of purple-shirted Kansas State fans were sprinkled throughout the crowd of 12,298, along with signs welcoming him back.

"I can't say enough about the people here in this town," Huggins said. "People have stuck with me through a lot of stuff, and I didn't expect that to change."

The Wildcats were on a roll when they hit town, having won six in a row with victories over Southern California and New Mexico in the Las Vegas Holiday Classic. A 3-minute spurt in the first half derailed their momentum.

Burrell scored nine points in a 15-2 run that broke open a close game and put Xavier ahead 35-24. Kansas State had five turnovers during the spurt, completed by Burrell's 3-pointer.

Burrell made a pull-up jumper and a driving layup, and Justin Cage scored on a drive to the basket for a 52-35 lead early in the second half. After Kansas State cut it to 68-58 with 5:39 to go, Josh Duncan had a fastbreak dunk and took a charge, helping Xavier rebuild the lead to 16 points.

David Hoskins led the Wildcats with 17 points.

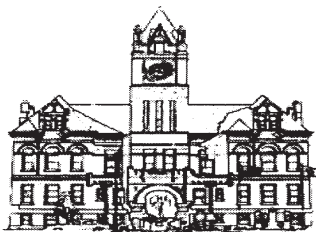
