# Lions learn about center

Three guests were present for the first March meeting of the High Plains Lions Club. Lion Wally Severson of the Gem Club, April McAdams of Colby, and Dr. Lynn Kreider were introduced by President Hazel Estes. Lion Sheryl Brenn leads the group in two songs before the group enjoyed a fried chicken buffet. Lion Roger Hale introduced President Kreider as the program speaker of the evening.

Dr. Kreider spoke on the proposed community and college Wellness/Activities Complex. He explained that the college had put together a committee and had the Docking Institute of Public Affairs Impact study to use in their final decision of the type and location of the proposed complex. He said the building would be a "green building" meaning it would be constructed for the best environmental efficiency. The building would be located at the corner of Franklin and College Drive.

The quick facts given were: The building will be a 115,000 square feet including a 2,400 seat competition gym, practice gym, wrestling practice room, locker rooms, an elevated walking track, free weights and machines room, a cardio center, all purpose class room, coaches offices, concession area, lobby and the entire complex will be handicapped accessible with an elevator to the second floor.

The complex includes a 240-car parking lot and a separate bus parking lot connected to a 260-bed dormitory located to the west of the wellness complex.

The Docking Institute indicates the complex would have the following impact on the community. \$30,932,000 increase in economic output of goods and services, \$10,972,000 increase in Thomas County earnings, 268.95 persons of jobs created in Thomas County. They also indicated that the long

term benefits for the community would include: each additional student would spend \$9,828 each 9 month period they are enrolled. \$15,528 of new sales is associated with each new student and earnings for the county would increase \$6,443.

In question and answers, Dr. Kreider pointed out that the swimming pool will stay at its present location. He expects to hire a full time director/AD for the complex with a full time athletic trainer for the facility. He was asked about charges for community use. His answer was the people are already paying for the facility, we would have to have some minimum fee for things like towel and laundry service. Dr. Kreider commented "I hope this facility will be a community center for families to come and use all year long, seven days a week. I foresee the college providing childcare for families who want to come and use the facilities as well a place people can come and gather for coffee."

He responded that he did not see this facility taking away anything from the community building or public school facilities. The college will still need the present gym for intramural activity and indoor practices and PE classes.

Dr. Kreider reminded everyone to vote April 3. He said the question on the ballot will be in two parts due to the type of financing they are using. "You just need to mark both question yes."

Following the program the club heard and took action on committee reports.

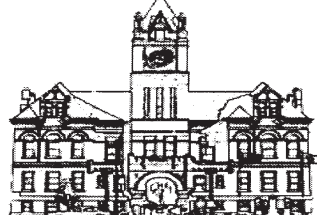
